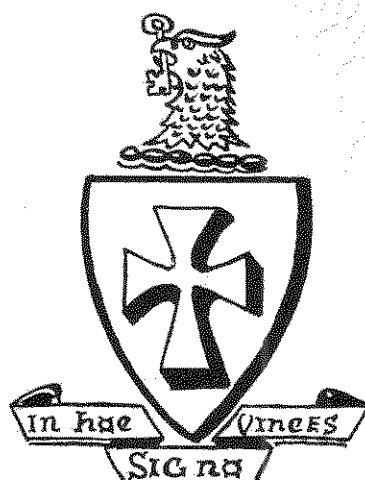


Sigma Chi
